

Animal Control Officer Certification

Program Overview:

This 40-hour certification course is designed to provide basic instruction in areas of concern to personnel whose duties include capture, control, keeping, and disposing of domestic and wild animals. The course consists of instruction in legal procedures as well as the use of restraint and capture equipment, report writing procedures, human, public and violator relations, and euthanasia considerations.
