COURSE: This course has been approved for Florida Certification under 828.27(4) Florida Statutes and uses the Florida Animal Control Association (F.A.C.A.) approved curriculum. Students are required to successfully complete this course before issuing citations for cruelty violations. Students must attend all sessions of the course and pass the state exam.

NOTE: Students will receive F.A.C.A. workbooks prior to the start of class and must agree to read and study the material prior to attending. Students are required to wear casual clothing, closed toe shoes, and long pants.
