

## BITE STICK / O.C. SPRAY CERTIFICATION TRAINING

Animal control officers and animal cruelty investigators who wish to obtain proper certification in the use of a bite stick and O.C. spray within the state of Florida.

This instructor-led classroom course provides instruction in areas of concern to animal control professionals whose duties may require the use of a bite stick and/or O.C. spray. Topics of instruction include, but are not limited to dangerous dog behavior, surviving dog attacks, Florida laws relating to weapons & aggravated assault / battery, proper decontamination procedures, and legally defensible documentation for use of force incidents.

This is a hands-on, physical training program involving classroom lectures, physical exercises, and a written final examination.
