

Lead Animal Control Officer

The Florida Keys SPCA in Key West FL is hiring an experienced Lead Animal Control Officer certified in the State of Florida or able to receive certification upon employment. This position enforces State Statute, County and City Ordinances relating to animals. The ACO will enforce animal control codes, issue warnings, citations and summons, and will pick up stray, trapped, abused, sick, DOA or injured animals as well as investigate cases of cruelty or neglect. This position will be responsible for educating our community on standards of care while also enforcing ordinances.

Qualifications include HS Diploma, two years' work or volunteer experience in animal handling, a valid driver's license and safe driving record. Must have Florida Animal Control Association (FACA) Animal Control Officer Certification or be able to attain it within 90 days of employment. Ability to pass a criminal background check is required.

This position will require some on call emergency and weekend shifts. Salary commensurate on experience and skills. The FKSPCA also offers a benefit package including employer paid medical insurance, LTD and paid vacation / sick / holiday time.
